Refunds will only be issued after successful completion of course modules.

- Attendance at all sessions is mandatory for CE credit. For RM15 extending over 8 weeks, attendance policy will be stipulated by the instructor in the 1st session.
- CE credits will be applied upon course completion.
- Upon completion, participants will be awarded a frame-worthy Certificate of Completion from the University of Colorado that demonstrates the participant's awareness of the covered topics.
- All course modules will be offered at University of Colorado Denver's (UCD) downtown Auraria campus.

- The deadline for receipt of the application at the end of this document is 10 days prior to the first day of class of the first selected course module.
- The Business School determines an applicant's eligibility to take RMI CE credit course modules once the application and supportive materials have been received. This ensures a common level of preparation since the instruction is shared with undergraduate RMI students at UCD, who are pursuing a degree.
